Kirkistown Castle Course - (Number 13 in Nth Ireland) 10.10 Tee times

A traditional links and the most easterly 18 hole golf course in Northern Ireland. The elevated tees and greens are a particular feature here giving Kirkistown Castle an envious reputation as a challenging test of golf for even the lowest of handicappers. The Course offers 'The Open' style of links golf where strategic play is a must in order to get close to the challenging Par 69 Course, but bearing in mind its 6,167 yards is longer than many courses with a Par 71. The Signature hole is the Par 4 10th; at 435 yards, it is reputed to be one of the most difficult Par 4s in Irish golf. The wonderful variety of holes will test every facet of your game with the wind adding to the hazards that exist already on the Course. Experience the magic that is Irish Links golf at its finest.

The 12th Par 3 is probably the most memorable hole on the Course providing magnificent views to the Mountains of Mourne. The 18th is a fine finishing hole playing towards the Clubhouse.

Royal Portrush: Dunluce Course (Number 2 in Nth Ireland – No 15 in World) 10.50am Tee Time

Voted No 12 in the World by Golf Magazine, this Course is a masterpiece of golf course architecture. Un-imaginable rough, testing greens and rugged links land, combined with the un-predictable weather of the North Atlantic makes this course an admirable test for even the most seasoned golfer. Darren Clarke, Rory McIlroy & Graeme McDowell are members of Royal Portrush with many golfers portraying the Dunluce Course as one of the most challenging courses in the World. The golf club was

founded in 1888 and has hosted many Championships, such as the first Open Championship ever held in Ireland in 1951. In more recent times, Royal Portrush has hosted the Senior British Open 1995-1999, The Amateur Championship in 1993 & 2014 and The Irish Open in 2012.

Derry is Ireland's only remaining walled city and offers 1500 years of social, cultural and religious history. Derry was initially a monastic settlement which became a plantation town and in later years it was a centre port for emigration to America, Australia and the UK. Derry City has been listed by many as one of the best experience they have had on their travels.

Castlerock GC (No 5 in Nth Ireland)

Castlerock, one of the most welcoming clubs in the land. The championship 18 is only slightly less vintage than Portrush GCs, but no less intoxicating. From the nerve-jangling fourth (200 yards, with the railway to the right and Snake River ditch to the left) to the innocuous 16th, Castlerock is simply beguiling. Course record holder Paul McGinley (64) stated "the greens out there were as good as if not better than the ones we played on at the Open at Royal Lytham"
